Liberty Hall

High on the North Berwyn Moors stand the crumbled remains of Liberty Hall. In days past it was a shooting lodge.

During the Second World War it was used as a lookout post so it is no surprise therefore that the location has exceptional 360 degree views over the moors and beyond.

It's quite a long and uphill walk from Corwen where you need to take the sign posted path to Pen y Pigyn. Continue onwards along the forest road, passing the refurbished reservoir wall on your right. When you come to two gates, look for the stile on the right of the right hand gate and then walk along the moorland road up to Liberty Hall. There are occasional sign posts for Liberty Hall.
