Corwen Waterfall

You are parked in Corwen main car park.
It's been raining for days and maybe it's still raining.
You don't think it's a good day for a walk.
It's a wonderful day to view a local waterfall.

Make your way out of the main car park passed the Pavilion on your left to reach the A5 main road.

Turn right passed Bargain Booze and on reaching a house called 'Osborne House', stand with your back to 'Osborne House' and look up the lane opposite. (The Old Workhouse is on the left of the lane).

Now you will see an enchanting waterfall as it descends into the recent Corwen flood defence scheme.

It falls all the way down Nant y Pigyn from the reservoir above Pen y Pigyn.

Why not walk some 200 yards up the lane for a closer look.

You will see to the right of the waterfall the public footpath which is well route marked and leads you up to the view point at Pen y Pigyn.

I bet you are tempted to go to Pen y Pigyn now where you will have super views over Corwen and beyond, (it has stopped raining hasn't it?).
