

Moel y Gaer, Nant y Ne & Moel Famau

If you happen to be descending from Moel Famau to Bwlch Pen Barras on the Offa's Dyke Path, look for a bench seat on your right.

Continue downwards and see a second bench seat on your right.

Just before this seat is a little green area.

Turn to look down to The Vale of Clwyd.

You will see a very faint path heading in that direction.

This path soon develops into no more than a deep rut in the heather but if you proceed downwards you are rewarded with fine views of Nant y Ne and Moel y Gaer. If you glance over your right shoulder the Jubilee Tower on Moel Famau is seen from a different angle.

If you persevere with this 'path' it eventually widens and then develops into a nice wide green path. This will lead you onto Moel y Gaer, probably one of the least visited hill forts of the Clwydian Range and well worth exploring.

It is best to retrace your steps unless you are familiar with the area as the path down to the Vale from Moel y Gaer is quite hard to locate amongst the gorse bushes.
